

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND RULES

1. The 116km Super Classic will be pre-entry only.
2. This event is run according to Cycling South Africa rules.
3. The ride will take place regardless of poor weather.
4. Entry fees will not be refunded should the ride be cancelled for any reason beyond the control of the organizers.
5. Sweep vehicles and emergency medical assistance will be on route.
6. Traffic officers and marshals will withdraw from the route six hours after the last start (116km).
7. All entrants participate entirely at their own risk and will have no claim whatsoever against organisers, sponsors or officials in respect of any loss, injury or damage related to the cycling event.
8. The wearing of hard shell helmets is compulsory and tri-bars are not permitted in any form.
9. The route will be as shown on the map. It is the sole and personal responsibility of all entrants to know the route, as the organisers take no responsibility for persons deviating from the route, or any consequences of such action.
10. Cyclists must obey all traffic rules, officials, and marshals, and ride in a responsible manner.
11. All cyclists must use the left hand lane. Any cyclist crossing the centre line will be disqualified. This rule will be strictly enforced.
12. Cyclists under the age of 16 must be accompanied at all times by an adult on the 116km event. No persons under the age of 12 years may enter the 116km event and no persons under the age of 10 years may enter the 62km event. All minors must have parental consent.
13. Cyclists must pull off the road to receive refreshments.
14. No seconding will be allowed from private vehicles. Only authorised support vehicles will be allowed on the route.
15. Slip-streaming behind private vehicles is strictly forbidden.
16. Race numbers MUST be worn by all participants.
17. By entering the event the entrant confirms that he/she is medically fit to complete the course, and that the cycle to be used is in a roadworthy condition. Cyclists must carry the necessary spares.

18. Participants in the 116km event must have a RaceTec timing device. No chip, no seeding, no time. Without a chip you may not be eligible for prize money.
19. Cut-off time is six hours after final start (116km).
20. Juveniles must ride with restricted gears.
21. CSA riders (top teams) will be categorised according to Cycling South Africa . All other cyclists to be seeded according to index.
22. Cash prizes to the value of R82,000.00 will be awarded according to the new Cycling South Africa categories. Prize giving from 10h30. Category winners (first 3 places) must be present at the prize-giving.
23. The judges' decision is final.
24. Failure to comply with any of the rules will result in disqualification.

PRIZE MONEY

116km event – Ernest Hunt Trophy

- ♦ R82,000 will be allocated according to the Cycling South Africa categories

62km event U/16 Boys and Girls

- ♦ Dis-Chem hampers to the first three places in each category

Graham Diesel Trophy and hamper for the 1st Para Cyclist over the finish line in either event

Special prize of R250 donated for the 1st person over the age of 75 years over the finish line in either event

DIRECTIONS TO START

N17 Johannesburg to Springs Highway, Rondebult [R21] offramp. North to Boksburg. Right into Bigwood (2nd lights). Right into Trichardt Road, left into Dudley Smith and right into Stadium.

N12 Johannesburg/Witbank Highway. Atlas Road offramp. South to Boksburg (R43), road becomes Van Dyk Road. Right into Commissioner Street, left into Jubilee Road.

[116km Late entries at registration, if available, no seeding and with a penalty charge]

62KM PRE-ENTRY: At Registration or at Event/Stadium [No penalty charge]

Water Point 1

30kms from the stadium on the R61 just South of Alrode [GPS S26°21'825^s E28°07'011^s]

Water Point 2

55kms from the stadium on the R557 just before the West entrance to Suikerbosrand [GPS S26°30'010s E28°07'233s]

Water Point 3

72kms from the stadium on the R42 near the Café Roesta [GPS S26°31'356s E28°19'350s]

Water Point 4

Approximately 93kms from the stadium on the R23 just beyond the route merge at 63kms from the R554 four-way stop [GPS S26°23'312s E28°20'725s]

Water Point 5

At the finish line at the stadium S26° 23' E28° 27'
