

“Important Information”

- 1 The SASKO Harties challenge is the first race after the winter season and is ideally suited to get on the bike again and to train for the big upcoming races like the 94.7
The route is easy to ride with some gentle hills like “Poeierkop” at the Telkom Satellite Station
- 2 There are two distances : 105 km and 33 km both starting at Bekker Primary School. The School is situated near Magaliesburg off the R24 in the direction of Hekpoort. (See Roadmap)
- 3 The 105 km race will be running along the undulating roads of the Magaliesburg Meander via the Telkom Satellite station down to the Hartbeespoort dam and back to Magaliesburg.
- 4 The race will be run according to the rules and regulations of the U.C.I.;
Cycling S.A. and C.N.G.
- 5 It is compulsory to wear a helmet: No Helmet, No Ride
Please remember to fit your chip: No Chip, No Time
- 6 Obey all Traffic rules and stay on the left hand side of the road.
Do not cross the white line.
It is for your own safety. Those who do not adhere to the rules will be disqualified. There will be Marshalls and Traffic officers at each intersection along the route. Please cooperate with them as the safety of this cycling event is largely in their hands.
- 7 On the route the riders must cross several railroads. Be careful when crossing the railroad when leaving Magaliesburg (10)km.) and again at Westlake (50km.)
- 8 The waterpoints are sponsored by SASKO and the refreshments by Magaliesburg Citrus
When taking on refreshments at waterpoints, move to the back of the bunch and to the left of the road to ensure safe passage.
Waterpoints are indicated on the route map.
- 9 Registration on site from 05h00 till 06h00.
Start of the race at 06h30
Cutt-Off time 13h00
Prizegiving 10h30
- 10 Accommodation is available at Bekker Primary School.

- 11 Netcare 911 will cover the route for any emergency. They have a reaction vehicle patrolling the route and an ambulance for any emergencies on standby on the route
